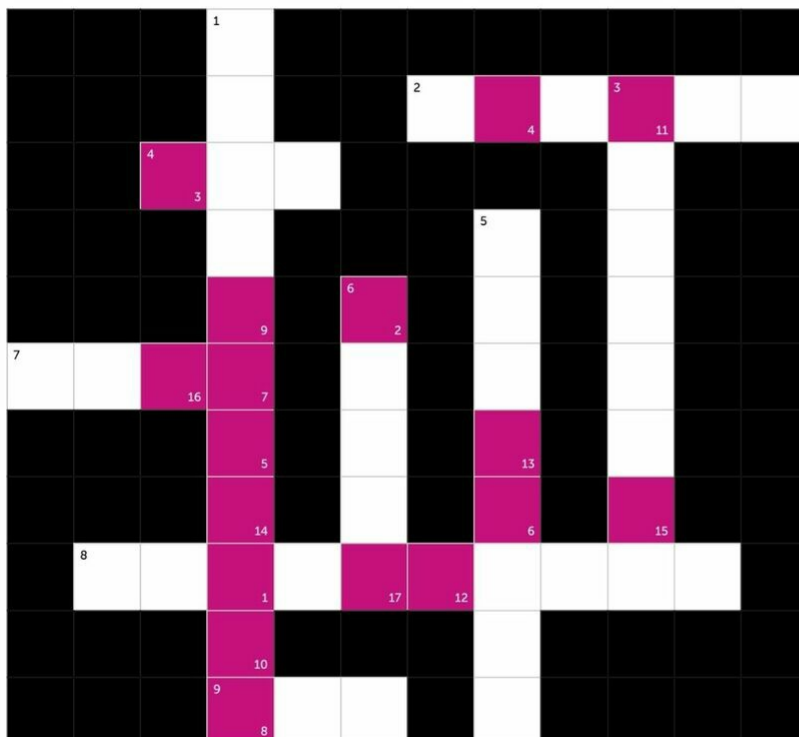

Agenda

Intro + Team Formation

When your guests arrive in the virtual meeting room, hosts will greet them, deliver the background of the case (which is inspired by real prohibition era history and figures), and divide the group into investigative teams.

10 minutes

Engaging + unexpected series of puzzles + challenges to earn clues Teams will work together to crack codes, search for hidden messages, and solve math puzzles that align with the story.
