Agenda

Welcome + intro

First round of museum stories

Renegade Museum Hack scavenger hunt	
Teams will receive scavenger hunt instructions and a pre-planned museum route and will set off to start the game. The experience includes trivia challenges and photo challenges. For example, teams might be asked to recreate a group painting, snap a photo on their phones, and upload them to a website at the end of the Scavenger Hunt.	60 minutes
Final story + photo presentations

Wrap up + conclusion	
After summing up the points, your host will declare the winners, offer necessary debriefs, and capture a team photo to commemorate the occasion. To end the event on a high note, a spirited team cheer will be performed, fostering a sense of celebration and unity.	10 minutes
